

# *Prescription Drug Insurance*

*All member schools offer the same Prescription Drug plan. The plan is administered through Caremark.*

## *How to Fill Prescriptions*

Mail Order: Mail your original prescription along with the fees or credit card information to Caremark using a form available through your district insurance administrator or by downloading a form. You may receive up to a 90-day supply of each drug. The cost is \$16 for brand name drug; or \$8 for its generic equivalent. To obtain a brand name drug when a generic is available, the prescribing physician must write “Dispense as Written” on the prescription.

You should allow up to three weeks from the time you mail your prescription until you receive your order by mail. If you do need your drugs more quickly, we suggest you ask your physician for two prescriptions: a small amount to get at your local pharmacy and a second to send in for mail order.

You may establish an online account at [www.caremark.com](http://www.caremark.com) to track the progress of your order, refill your prescription, compare costs, and obtain a wealth of other information.

Local Pharmacy: Take your original prescription to a local pharmacy that is a member of the Caremark network. Most pharmacies belong to the network. If you do not know whether your favorite pharmacy is a member, we recommend you go to

[www.caremark.com](http://www.caremark.com) and click on “find a local pharmacy”. You may receive up to a 34-day supply of each prescription. The cost is \$10 for a brand name drug, or \$5 for its generic equivalent. To obtain a brand name drug, your physician must write “Dispense as Written” on the prescription.
