

**Medical, Dental, Prescription Drug Insurance
Dependent Eligibility for Coverage
Effective July 1, 2006**

Dependent Children will be covered if:

- They are not married and;
- They are not eligible for benefit through their employer or they have to pay 50% or more of the premium to get the benefits and;
- They have not reached the limiting age of 24.

In fairness to the currently covered children the limiting age for child with a birth year of 1983 or earlier will be the end of the month that they turn age 25. For children with a birth year of 1984 or later it will be the end of the month that they turn age 24. Please remember that COBRA coverage is available once a child is no longer eligible for benefits.

Please remember to contact your district insurance administrator when your child gets near the limiting age. You may need to complete a form to remove your child from your insurance plan.
